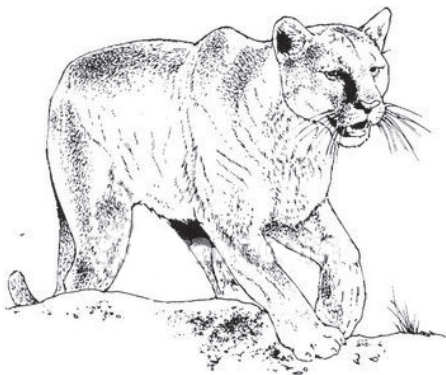

## OFFICE UPDATE

from Sharon Kennedy, Assistant Principal/Site Administrator



### Dear Parents,

International Baccalaureate – By now you have probably heard that the schools in Incline Village plan to begin implementation of this program in August, 2010. Also known as IB, this program has the possibility of offering our students the opportunity to participate in courses with increased rigor throughout their Kindergarten through twelfth grade experience.

What does this mean at Incline Middle School? There will be a few obvious changes and some more subtle differences from the current course offerings and schedule. The biggest change will be that all students will take the eight courses required by IB. Those classes include Language A (most likely Language Arts), Language B (likely to be Spanish), Humanities (likely to be Social Studies), Science, Math, PE, Technology, and Arts (either performing or visual). All of these are currently available at IMS. Right now, students have the option of taking a second language; might take technology for one, two, or no years; might take a music or art class; or might opt out of PE for one semester in eighth grade. The difference is that the new program requires that all students receive at least 50 hours of instruction, spread throughout the entire school year, in each subject, every year of the Middle Years Program (MYP).

The change in course requirements means that we must change our class schedules. A committee is working on options for the 2010-11 school year and we hope to have a firm format within the next month. Students and parents will receive information about the new schedules before school lets out for summer in June.

Implementation of IB at IMS will be a process that is expected to take more than one year. Teachers and administration are continuing with professional development in subject areas and WCSD has held several community forums on the program. The next forum is scheduled to focus on the MYP and is slated to take place on April 21 at 6:30 PM in the forum at IMS. I invite you to attend and hear more about the program.

## EARLY REGISTRATION FOR 2010-2011

Incline Middle School will be implementing early registration for the 2010-2011 school year. Packets will be sent home with student's advisory on May 3rd. All forms need to be completed and returned to the school no later than May 17. Any questions, please feel free to contact Incline Middle School at 832-4220.

## 2010-2011 NEW IMMUNIZATION REQUIREMENT FOR 7TH GRADE ENTRY

**Dear Parents,**

Based on a recent decision by the Nevada legislature and on updated recommendations from the Washoe County District Health Department, students entering 7th grade in the Washoe County School District will be required to show proof of immunization against tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis (Tdap) prior to school enrollment for the 2010-2011 school year.

Pertussis, also known as whooping cough, is a highly contagious respiratory tract infection that can occur in places like middle schools, where there is close interaction among large numbers of students. Although most children are immunized against pertussis before enrolling in kindergarten, immunity wears off over time and leaves adolescents unprotected.

This new requirement affects all students entering 7th grade, provided at least 5 years have passed since the student's last childhood tetanus-containing vaccine (Td, DTP or DTaP).

Parents are encouraged to review their child's shot record and make arrangements with their health care provider for vaccination prior to the busy 'Back to School' season. School begins on August 23, 2010.

The Mountain Lion wrestling team capped off its season with four wrestlers competing in the championships held in Fallon, NV on March 27th. The four wrestlers to make the trip included **Jasmine Crandall, Owen Price-Skelly, Kelsey Philpot, and Adam Swick**. It was great for the wrestlers to experience the championship event that experience will prove beneficial in all their wrestling careers. I was really happy to see all three of the seventh grade wrestlers qualify; it shows that their hard work and dedication to the team the last two seasons has paid off.

Adam Swick brought home a fourth place medal making him the only Mountain Lion to place, Adam started the season strong and finished it the same way. Adam ended the season with a 19-4 record with 18 of those wins resulting from first round pins.
