HIGH SCHOOL REGISTRATION

On-line or mail in only (no walk-in registrations)

Students may register for 1st and/or 2nd session classes.

- April 19** **CURRENT** seniors and juniors **ONLY** may begin registration.
- April 26** **CURRENT** sophomores and freshmen may begin registration.
- May 3** Graduating 8th graders may begin registering for **Computer Lit., Health, or PE ONLY**

Walk-in registrations accepted as well as on-line and mail-in.

- May 25** Walk-in registration is accepted May 25 to June 11, 8 a.m. – 4 p.m.
- June 11** First Session enrollment ends.

Mail-in registration will be accepted only from April 19 through June 1. Any mail-in forms post-marked after June 1st will be returned to sender. **DO NOT USE INTERNAL SCHOOL DISTRICT MAIL.**

- June 25** Second Session enrollment ends. No more registrations will be accepted Any enrollment post marked after June 25 will be returned.

Grades 6, 7, and 8 May begin Registering on-line on April 19

CBI (Computer Based Instruction) Only Math, Language Arts, Science and Social Studies
Students sign up for ONE 2-hour period ONLY. Students may complete as many courses as needed (one at a time) during the six-week session (at no additional cost). Unless the student is attending Summer School because of attendance issues, the MS student may stop attending as soon as the required courses they need to complete to move to the next grade level are successfully completed. New students may enroll whenever an opening appears on the website.

If PLATO courses are incomplete at the end of the six-week session, the student may be able to continue the course at the zoned school in September. The student will be enrolled first in whichever subject the counselor feels is most needed. Once that course is completed, the student will ask the teacher to be enrolled in the next course.
